

## HB 2210 (Party Affiliation) Key Points

### *Who This Statute Affects:*

Persons who live in a district where a candidate from their currently registered party, DOES NOT file for election. Example: you are a registered Democrat, but no Democrat files in your district you may want to change party affiliation so that you can have a vote in the Republican primary so that you will have a voice in the election.

### *Statute Language:*

This year, the law becomes effective on July 1, 2014. However, it is recommended that you file for a change of party affiliation now. The deadline THIS YEAR is effectively Monday, June 30, 2014. The candidate filing deadline of June 1, will become the annual deadline for affiliation changes AFTER the law becomes effective on July 1, of this year.
